A SAFE RIDE A MEMORIAL TO COLLINS

Mr. John C. Collins of Acton, Massachusetts, passed away recently, of complications due to an incident on a local escalator. Mr. Collins daughter, Patricia D. Duffey contacted the Foundation in an effort to keep other seniors safe. She requested that in lieu of flowers, a donation be sent to EESF and earmarked for the A Safe Ride program for Senior Citizens.

The Foundation has received \$1580 in Mr. Collins memory.

For every \$25 contribution, EESF is able to educate approximately 100 seniors on the safe riding habits while riding elevators, escalators and moving walks.
