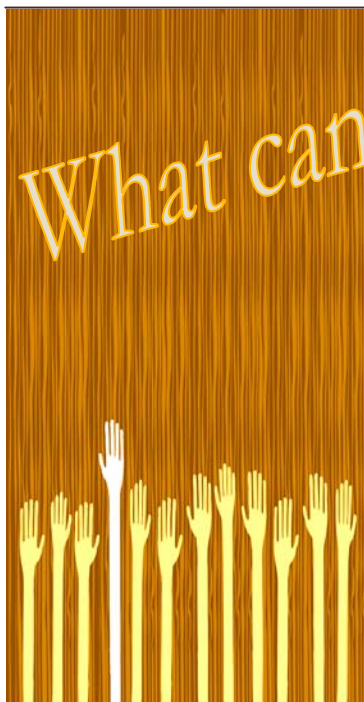
A Letter from the 2010 Campaign Chairman

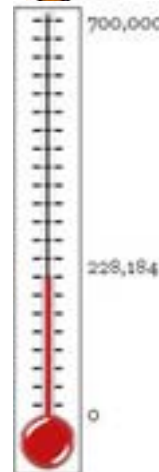
EESF Needs YOU!
